## ABOUT THIS MAP

This map illustrates the District's important role in working with partners to create a connected system of recreational lands and trails as described in the Recreation and Education section of *Connecting Communities and the Land: A Long-Range Acquisition Plan*. It is not intended for use without the associated objectives and policies. Recreational lands owned or protected by the District are highlighted, as are other public recreational lands. The District will focus future acquisition efforts on identifying potential recreational connections between parks, trails and communities.
