## 4. General Announcements Not Requiring Deliberation or Decision.

Mr. Keene made the following announcements:

• On March 22, 2018, the Fiscal Oversight Commission and the Advisory Committee will hold a joint meeting to review the Vital Lands Initiative. The meeting will be held at Finley Center, 2060 West College Avenue, Santa Rosa, from 5:00 pm to 7:00 pm.

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The District will take a draft version of the Vital Lands Initiative to the Board of Directors on May 8, 2018; and the final initiative to the Board of Directors on June 5, 2018. A draft is being released to the public tomorrow for review and comment.

- Jamie Bloom, Risk Management Analyst with Human Resources, will provide general information about the County's "All-Risk" insurance coverage, and specifically coverage and potential claims resulting from damage to District-held properties resulting from the October firestorm. The potential date is the Commission's May meeting.
- Sheri Emerson has prepared an inventory of properties affected by the firestorm, including the estimated financial impact on each property, and the status of potential reimbursement by FEMA.

Duane De Witt, representing Roseland Action, spoke to the Commission about a project currently under consideration by the City of Santa Rosa, Roseland Creek Park Acquisition, potentially funded, in part, through the District's Matching Grant Program.

John McCullough, a property owner of a land transaction currently in negotiations with the District, and his daughter, Carolyn McCullough-Sharp, spoke in support of the District's acquisition of portions of their land for permanent protection and transition to a County-owned park.

Bert Whitaker, Director of Regional Parks, spoke in support of the acquisition and project. Rob Schepergerdes, representing the McCulloughs, spoke in support of the acquisition.
