Call to Order

Chair Dell'Osso called the meeting to order at 5:03 pm.

Public Comment

No public comment.

Approval of Minutes

Paul Martin motioned to approve the minutes from December 12, 2019 as is, and Bill Smith seconded the motion. All in favor, with four abstentions from Jan McFarland, Cary Fargo, Austin Maners and Tawny Tesconi who were not in attendance at the December meeting.

General Manager's Report Out

- Bill Keene, General Manager, welcomed Austin Maners as a youth member to his first Advisory Committee meeting. Austin introduced himself to the members and staff. He attends Analy High School and has been in 4H for nine years.
- The Taylor Mountain Cooper Creek extension, north of Farmers Lane, will go to the Board February 4, 2020.

- The Outings and Youth Education Program is going to the Board on March 10, 2020.
- Gloeckner Ranch is going to the Board on March 24, 2020. This is a 3,400 acre property that runs cattle and has a vineyard along the road. Sonoma Land Trust with the Moore Foundation contributed \$500,000, and Sonoma Water contributed \$15,000 which will allow them to hold educational tours about the watershed for children. The property is adjacent to a Water Education Facility and is part of the Dry Creek watershed.
- Oken Property Riparian Restoration Phase III will go to the Board on April 7, 2020.
- The Stewardship Workshop/Update will go to the Board on April 13, 2020.
- Ag + Open Space is involved in a court trial regarding the Bordessa property that is located
 on the Estero Americano. The first phase of the trial has prevailed on every cause of action
 and now phase one is complete and phase two has begun. The trial should end by February
 11, 2020. Mr. Keene will give a full report out on the trial at next month's Advisory
 Committee meeting.

Advisory Committee Administration

a) Election of Committee Officers

Chair Dell'Osso announced that all three of the current committee officers were still interested in their positions, but would step down if anyone else on the committee would like to volunteer. No once came forward. Paul Martin nominated the same officers to continue: John Dell'Osso as Chair, Don McEnhill as Vice Chair and Curt Nichols as Chair Pro Tem. Jan McFarland seconded that motion. A vote was taken and all were in favor, no oppositions or abstentions.

b) Advisory Committee Rules of Procedure

Chair Dell'Osso asked for a review of the Advisory Committee Rules of Procedure. The Rules of Procedure are tentatively scheduled for discussion at the March Advisory Committee meeting as they need some updating. Staff will be working with County Counsel and the Advisory Executive Committee to draft a new document for member consideration. It will then need to be considered and approved by the Board.

c) Ad Hoc Subcommittee Assignments

No new subcommittees were formed. The only current subcommittee is the Matching Grant Program. It was decided that a Matching Grant Program committee will be formed after the closing of the Matching Grant Program process in April or May.

d) Committee Calendar and Roster

Chair Dell'Osso asked members to review the calendar dates for meetings in 2020. The members chose to decide on a summer month off at a later date as it gets closer.



Subcommittee Report Out

The Advisory Committee currently has one active subcommittee, the Matching Grant Program. There has been no meeting since the January 23, 2020 Advisory Committee meeting so no report out this evening.

Upcoming Board Workshop: Stewardship Policy, Fee Lands Strategy, Stewardship Reserve Fund and Investment Strategy

Sheri Emerson, Stewardship Manager, has been preparing to take a Stewardship Update/Workshop to the Board on April 13, 2020. This workshop will focus on the current Stewardship Program as well as the long term work beyond the measure. Ms. Emerson presented a PowerPoint that went over the Stewardship program including the Stewardship policy, Fee Lands Strategy, and Stewardship Reserve Fund and investment strategy. Ag + Open Space is committed to stewarding the lands protected into perpetuity. She asked for comments from Advisory Committee members by January 31, 2020 either through meetings, email or phone calls. A discussion took place with the members and Chair Dell'Osso opened the discussion up to public comment.
