All were in favor, with eight abstentions from Steve Barbose, Austin Maners, Michelle Whitman, Tawny Tesconi, Jan McFarland, Evan Wiig, Doug Lipton, and Paul Martin who were not in attendance at the February meeting.

# General Manager's Report Out

- Bill Keene, General Manager, introduced the newest member of the Advisory Committee, Michelle Whitman, who is representing the third district. Ms. Whitman introduced herself to the Advisory Committee members and staff.
- A prescribed grazing contract for Calabazas is going to the Board on June 9, 2020.
- The transfer of Carrington Ranch to Regional Parks is also going to the Board on June 9, 2020. This is a 300 acre property off of Coleman Valley Road.
- Mr. Keene acknowledged staff on all they have accomplished during the COVID-19
  pandemic. Several staff have been devoted to disaster service as runners, working on public
  information, press releases, contact tracing, the emergency hot line, and sewing face
  coverings. Most staff are sheltering in place and working from home if they are not
  participating in disaster services and have been very productive. All meetings are being
  conducted remotely.

The Advisory Committee currently has one active subcommittee, the Matching Grant Program. The configuration of members may change once applications have been received in August.
