## Call to Order

Chair Whitman called the meeting to order at 5:02 pm.

## **Public Comment**

Chair Whitman asked for any public comments on items not on the agenda. Susan Sullivan had a public comment on Paula Lane, and was directed to say her comment during that part of the agenda.

## Approval of Minutes from June 24, 2021

Chair Whitman asked for any comments or revisions regarding the June 24, 2021 minutes. There were none. The minutes were unanimously approved. There were no public comments on the minutes.

#### General Manager's Report

- Misti Arias, General Manager, reported that Ag + Open Space has received a grant from the State Coastal Conservancy for \$575,000 for high priority tree thinning and shaded fuel break work on Saddle Mountain, which burned in the Glass Fire. The SCC then contacted the Ag + Open Space and said that there was an additional \$80,000 in funds available. This is going to the Board on August 17, 2021 for approval of the grant and there will be a Request for Proposal process to pick a contractor for the tree work. The contract for this work will go to the Board on September 28, 2021.
- Calabazas Creek Open Space Preserve has been officially transferred to Regional Parks. Ag +
  Open Space hosted a media visit to the property last Friday in conjunction with the closing
  of the transfer. Attendees included Supervisor Susan Gorin; Misti Arias, General Manager;
  Leslie Lew, Stewardship Specialist; and Karen Davis-Brown, Regional Parks Planner.

# Paula Lane Update

Ms. Arias, Jennifer Kuszmar, Acquisition Manager, and Jake Newell, Stewardship Specialist, gave an update on the Paula Lane Matching Grant Program project, providing background of the project, overview of terms of the matching grant agreement and conservation easement, and Ag + Open Space's role.

Advisory Committee members and the public had questions regarding the badgers on site, and Patrick Carter, City of Petaluma Senior Management Analyst and Dana Riggs, Sol Ecology CEO, Founder and Principal Biologist, answered them as they were able.


